The Power of Multiplication:

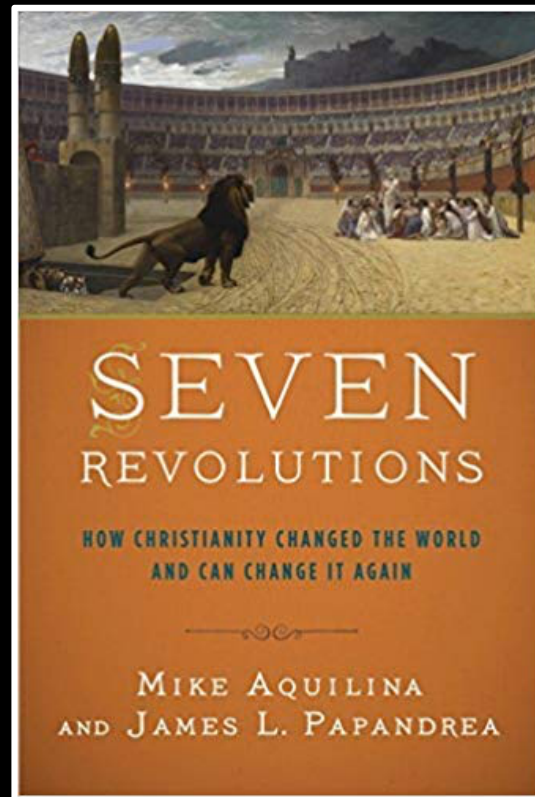
If the population of China (1.4 billion people) walked passed you in a line single file, the line would never end because of the multiplying birth rate!

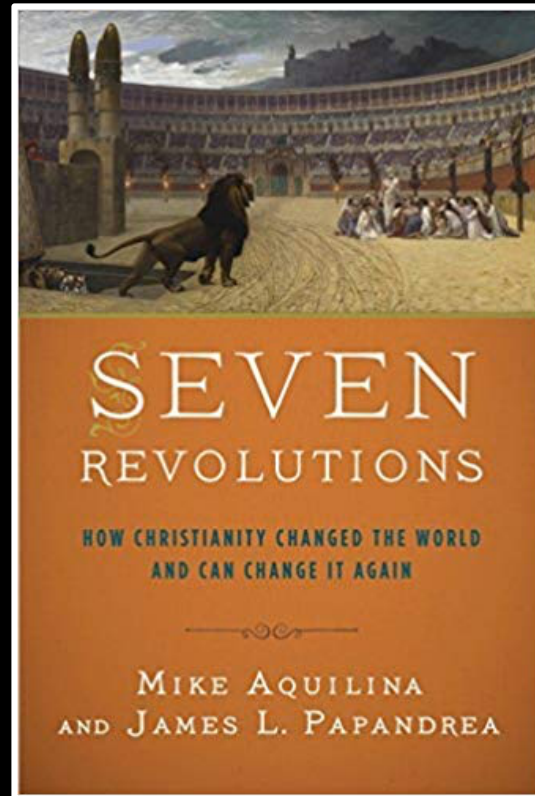
