# The Danger of Playing God (James 4:11-17)

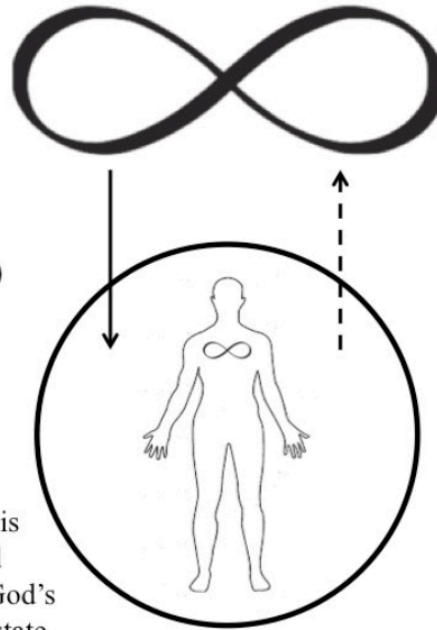
## CREATOR (GOD)
