

O HOLY NIGHT, PART 3
HE KNOWS OUR NEED
Hebrews 2:9-18; 4:15-16

Christmas shows that God cares about our every need.

“O Holy Night” (from v. 2)

In all our trials born to be our Friend!
He knows our need—to our weakness is no stranger.

Know that God cares about our PHYSICAL needs.

The creation speaks of God’s devotion to the physical. (2:9b, 14d, 16b)

The incarnation speaks of God’s devotion to the physical. (2:9a, 11b, 14a)

The resurrection speaks of God’s devotion to the physical. (2:9c, 14b)

God’s people cannot be indifferent toward other people’s physical needs.

Know that God cares about our EMOTIONAL needs.

Sympathy is one of God’s gifts to his people. (2:10b, 17a; 4:15)

Serenity is one of God’s gifts to his people. (2:15-16)

Significance is one of God’s gifts to his people. (2:11c-13)

God’s people cannot be indifferent toward other people’s emotional needs.

Know that God cares about our SPIRITUAL needs.

God provides help in our times of temptation. (2:18; 4:16)

God provides his Son as our atoning substitution. (2:9d, 17b)

God provides his people with a glorious destination. (2:10a)

God’s people cannot be indifferent toward other people’s spiritual needs.
